Community Eligibility Provision

Dear Parent or Guardian:

We are pleased to inform you that the Southern Local School District will again be implementing a new option available to schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs called the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for School Year 2017-2018.

What does this mean for you and your children attending the *Southern Elementary*?

Great news for you and your students! All enrolled students of

Southern Elementary School, Grades Pre-K thru 8th grade

are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at **no charge** to your household each day of the 2017-2018 school year. No further action is required of you. Your child(ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay a fee or submit an application. Yes! This means a free lunch!

This program applies to the Elementary only! Parents with children in high school must fill out a free/reduced lunch application each year like in the past. High School Lunches are \$2.70 .
